ANEMONE PLUS – Project Description

The National Institute for Marine Research and Development "Grigore Antipa" (NIMRD), as Lead Partner, participates in the ANEMONE PLUS project (Assessing the Vulnerability of the Black Sea Marine Ecosystem to Human Pressures – Promoting Collaboration with Business, Governance, and Citizens for a Sustainable Blue Region), implemented under the Interreg (VI-B) NEXT Black Sea Basin Programme, project code BSB00949. The project brings together six partners from four Black Sea riparian countries — Romania, Bulgaria, Ukraine, and Turkey — with the overall objective of enhancing the resilience and sustainability of the Black Sea ecosystem by advancing the assessment of its vulnerabilities to human and climate pressures, through strengthening research and innovation capacities and adopting advanced technologies. Key expected results include the development of an integrated WebGIS platform for real-time monitoring of marine ecosystem health, improved tools for assessing eutrophication, pollution, biodiversity loss, and blue carbon, as well as strengthened transnational scientific cooperation and stakeholder engagement for sustainable marine and coastal management in the Black Sea region. The project runs for 30 months, with implementation not exceeding 31 December 2029. The total eligible budget of the project is 1,482,285.55 EUR, of which 1,334,056.99 EUR (90%) is co-funded by the European Union through Interreg Funds under the Interreg NEXT Black Sea Basin Programme. NIMRD's total eligible budget amounts to 389,052.00 EUR, of which 350,146.80 EUR is supported by Interreg Funds.
