## STUDENT INTERNSHIP IN NIMRD “GRIGORE ANTIPA”

During **15-21.07.2013**, **28 students** of the **Agricultural Sciences and Veterinary Medicine University Bucharest - Specialization Fish Farming** (year I and II) performed an internship stage in the National Institute for Marine Research and Development “Grigore Antipa” Constanta. The Romanian students were joined by a group of **South Korean students, from the University of Natural Sciences in Seoul**.



The aim of this stage was to allow the students to familiarize themselves with the marine research area and to apply the research carried-out in the Institute in practice. Throughout the week, the schedule of this internship included the presentation of NIMRD and its activity (Scientific Director Tania Zaharia, PhD), a work visit in the Institute (guided by Victor Nita, PhD student), presentations of the Black Sea habitats and biodiversity (Victor Nita, PhD student), the Vama Veche - 2 Mai Marine Reserve (Magda Nenciu, PhD student), the state of the Black Sea fishery resources (Valodia Maximov, PhD) and fishing gears used at the Black Sea (Eugen Anton, PhD). The major projects NIMRD is part in (including CoCoNet) were presented to the students. The schedule also included a practical ichthyology laboratory (Madalina Cristea, PhD student), a work visit aboard the “Steaua de Mare” research vessel and was concluded by a visit at the Natural Sciences Museum Complex.
